


Skooties have launched on Indiegogo!

Skooties are crowdfunding on Indiegogo and have a target goal of \$55,000. This amount will backfill costs for research and development, provide infrastructure for mass production and distribution, and marketing. The campaign is from February 22 - April 7, 2023.

There are multiple crowdfunding backing levels and perks include items such as postcards, roller skate wheel bags, 3-way skate tools and pairs of Skooties.
